- 1) Did you know your dog's mother?
(a) Yes (b) No
- 2) Where did you get your dog from?
(a) The pound (b) Stray (c) Rescue (d) Breeder (e) "Friend"
- 3) Say the word "pizza" to your dog. How does your dog respond?
(a) Acts the same (b) Wags tail (c) Appears hesitant and knowing
- 4) Look at your phone bill. Have there been any calls made to numbers you do not recognize?
(a) No (b) Yes, but who remembers all their calls? (c) Yes, and many of them were made while I was asleep.
- 5) Does your dog watch television with you?
(a) No (b) Yes, but doesn't pay attention (c) Yes, and he likes cop shows.
- 6) Does your dog prefer wet food to dry food?
(a) Dry food (b) Wet food (c) he only eats freshly killed meat
- 7) Have you ever, at a party or a barbecue, fed your dog beer?
(a) No (b) Yes
- 8) If your answer to Question 7 was (b) then did your dog like it?
(a) No (b) Yes
- 9) Have you ever seen your dog eat a rice and bean burrito?
(a) No (b) Yes
- 10) Do other dogs like your dog, try to fight with your dog, or avoid your dog?
(a) Like (b) Fight (c) Avoid
- 11) Do you have a hard time finding pens or keys? Do things seem to move around your house on their own?
(a) Never (b) Sometimes (c) Often

12) Does your dog prefer sleeping at the head of the bed, the foot of the bed, or on his own bed?

(a) Head (b) Foot (c) I don't know where my dog sleeps

13) Have you noticed any eggs disappearing from the fridge?

(a) No (b) Yes

14) WARNING: THIS LAST TEST SHOULD BE PERFORMED ON A LEASH AND IN A PUBLIC PLACE

Say "I know what you did last night." to your dog. Does he look:

(a) Bewildered (b) Normal (c) Menacing

If you answered (c) to two or more questions, immediately contact Animal Control.

If you answered (b) to four or more questions, continue to monitor your dog's behavior closely.
