

Calculating Fulfillment Fees

Follow the steps below and the tables at right to determine the cost for fulfilling an item using Fulfillment by Amazon.

Step 1 - Inventory Storage¹

Use the table Inventory Storage. Storage fees are charged for all units stored in an Amazon fulfillment center based on calendar month and your daily average volume (measured in cubic feet). You pay only for the space you use.

Step 2 - Determine Order Types

Use the table Amazon.com Fulfillment for any orders placed on Amazon.com.² Use the table Multi-Channel Fulfillment for any fulfillment shipments you request for orders placed elsewhere or for product removal.³

Step 3 - Determine Unit Types

Media, non-media and oversize – Media units include books, music, software, video games and videos (DVD, VHS). Non-Media units include everything else. An Oversize Unit is any unit, media or non-media, that is greater in any one dimension than 18" long x 14" wide x 8" high or weighing 20 pounds or more.

Step 4 - Calculate Fulfillment Fee

Amazon.com Fulfillment

- A** **Order Handling** – Add \$1.00 if your fulfillment order contains one or more Non-Media units.
- B** **Pick & Pack** – A fee is applied to each unit in your fulfillment order. If a unit has a retail price less than \$25.00, use the corresponding row for that unit. If the unit's retail price is \$25 or greater, use the corresponding row for that unit.
- C** **Weight Handling** – For each unit, multiply the packaged weight by \$0.40. For an order with multiple units, add the fee for each individual unit to get the total fee.

TOTAL – The sum of A, B and C is the fulfillment fee.

–OR–

Multi-Channel Fulfillment

- D** **Pick & Pack** – A fee is applied to each unit in your fulfillment order. Oversized items will be charged at the Oversized rate.
- E** **Shipping Method** – Determine a Shipping Method. For shipments with mixed unit types, use the highest applicable fee.
- F** **Shipping Weight** – Determine a Shipping Method. Multiply your total shipment weight by the applicable weight range row.

TOTAL – The sum of D, E and F is the fulfillment fee.

Did You Know...

Inventory Storage

This fee is assessed to every unit for as long as it's in the fulfillment center.

Monthly Storage (per cubic foot)

January through September	\$0.45 / cubic foot ¹ per month
October through December	\$0.60 / cubic foot ¹ per month

- The cubic feet of any Unit will be based on the Unit's size as properly packaged and ready for shipment to customers in accordance with the Guidelines. Amazon will be entitled to make its own measurement of the cubic feet or weight of any packaged unit or representative sample thereof, and in the event of any conflict between such measurement and information provided by Seller, Amazon's measurement will govern.
- Amazon.com Fulfillment rates apply to orders that are placed on Amazon.com and qualify for shipping promotions and customer service, as detailed in the Fulfillment by Amazon Agreement. Fees related to listing and selling items on Amazon.com still apply.
- Multi-Channel Fulfillment rates apply to requests that are submitted by seller directly and cover transportation and handling only. If Amazon splits fulfillment requests into multiple shipments, transportation charges will be applied to each shipment separately (resulting in lower transportation charges for you).
- Removals will be charged for Pick & Pack only.
- The maximum weight for any single unit to be fulfilled by Amazon is 150 pounds. Please consult the FBA Manual for detailed information about product restrictions. Multi-Channel Fulfillment order item weights are the greater of either actual weight or the "dimensional weight" as calculated: (Length x Width x Height)/194.
- When calculating Fulfillment by Amazon fees for orders that include oversized items, each oversized item in the order is assessed the applicable fees as a unique order. Note: Each oversized item is generally sent as a single shipment in its own package, therefore Amazon does not aggregate the fees for multiple-item orders that include oversized items.

You may request that your inventory be returned to you or disposed of at any time. Inventory Removals will be billed at the rate listed in the Multi-Channel Fulfillment table and Disposals will be billed at the Multi-Channel Fulfillment rate for Pick and Pack.
