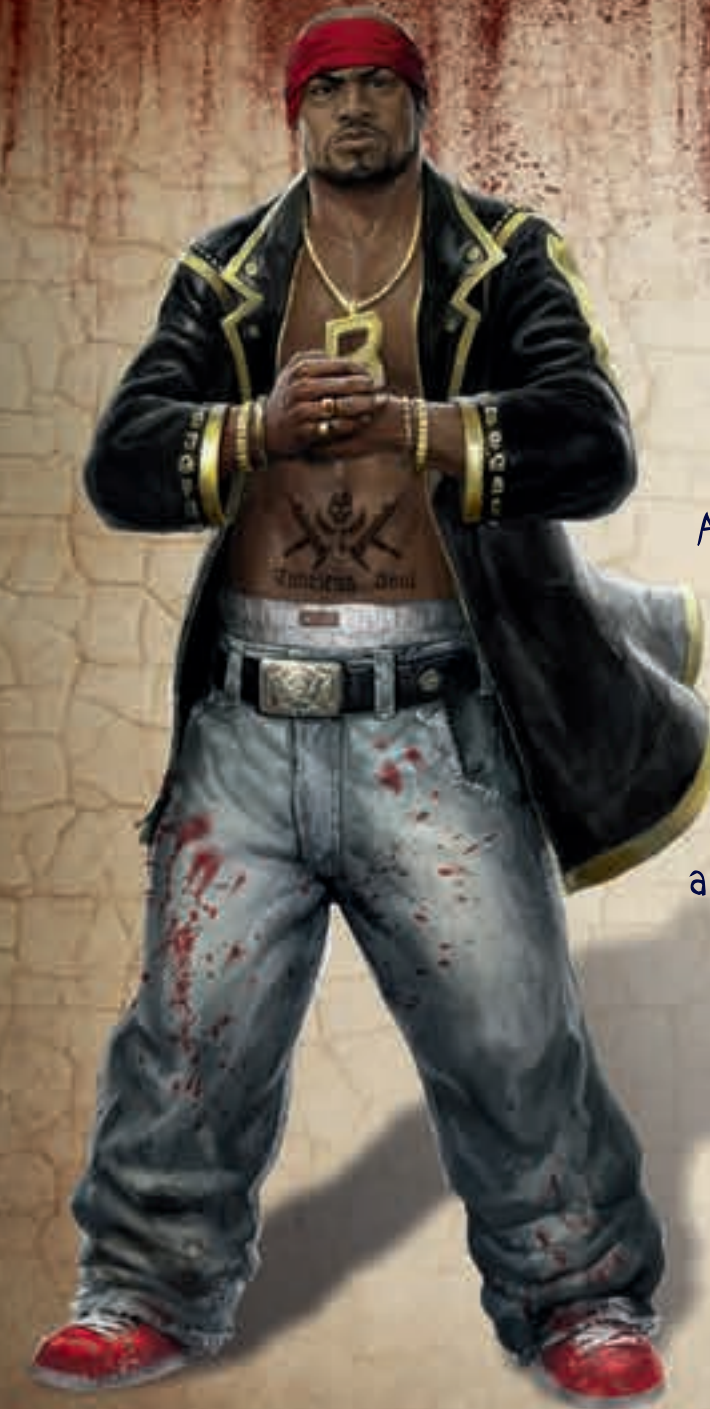

Crime is a serious problem in Papua New Guinea, especially in the cities. When young men migrate to urban areas and are unable to find a job they turn to crime. The largest city in Papua New Guinea, Port Moresby, has a 60% unemployment rate.

Raskol is the local word used to refer to gang members or criminals in general. It is derived from the English word rascal. Only 10% of the population of Papua New Guinea lives in cities.

Papua New Guinea consists of eastern New Guinea along with New Britain, New Ireland, Bougainville, and six hundred small islands and archipelagos.

Following the second World War, the Australian Territory of Papua and the once German-controlled New Guinea were united into one territory under Australian administration. Papua New Guinea gained its independence from Australia in September of 1975.

Much of the Territory of New Guinea was occupied by the Japanese during World War II. It was finally recaptured by Australian and American forces during the New Guinea campaign, one of the major military campaigns of WWII. There are still many Japanese bunkers and airstrips left on the islands of Papua New Guinea after World War II.

"Papua" is a Malay word for frizzy hair, while "New Guinea" comes from the belief that the island's inhabitants resembled those on the African continent. Over 60,000 tourists visit Papua New Guinea each year.

Papua New Guinea is one of the few regions in the equator to experience snow fall which occurs on the highest mountain peaks on the mainland. Papua New Guinea has one of the world's largest remaining tropical rainforests, and the largest in the Asia-Pacific region.

Papua New Guinea is located at the point of collision of several tectonic plates, on the so-called Pacific Ring of Fire. There are several active volcanoes, earthquakes are common and they are sometimes accompanied by tsunamis. Kuru is a transmissible, incurable and fatal brain disease that was responsible for an epidemic

There are three official languages of Papua New Guinea: English is the language of the government and the education system, Tok Pisin (New Guinea Pidgin) is the lingua franca and Hiri (or Polio) Motu is used in the south.

According to the 2000 census, 96% of PNG citizens were Christian, though many combine their Christian faith with traditional indigenous beliefs and practices, such as animism and ancestor worship.

In the early 2000s, there were 3 doctors per 100,000 people in Papua New Guinea.

Papua New Guinea is a member of the Commonwealth of Nations with the British monarch as its head of state.

The Maori are the indigenous people of New Zealand. They are well-known for their permanent face and body markings called "ta moko".

In September of 2009, over 50 prisoners escaped from Port Moresby's Bomana maximum security prison by digging a hole in the fence around their cell block.

In January of 2010, another 12 prisoners escaped from Port Moresby's Bomana maximum security prison. One of the escapees was PNG's most notorious underworld figure, accused of multiple robberies, rape, kidnapping and the murder of a police officer.

Human remains have been found in PNG dating to about 50,000 years ago. The mainland was one of the first landmasses after Africa and Eurasia to be populated by modern humans.

With over 820 indigenous languages, Papua New Guinea has more languages than any other country in the world, constituting 12% of the global total. Papua New Guinea has the highest incidence of HIV and AIDS in the Pacific region and fits the criteria for a generalized HIV/AIDS epidemic. In 1933 sea shells were abolished as the currency of Papua New Guinea.

Papua New Guinea has several thousand separate communities, most with only a few hundred people, each divided by language, customs, and tradition.

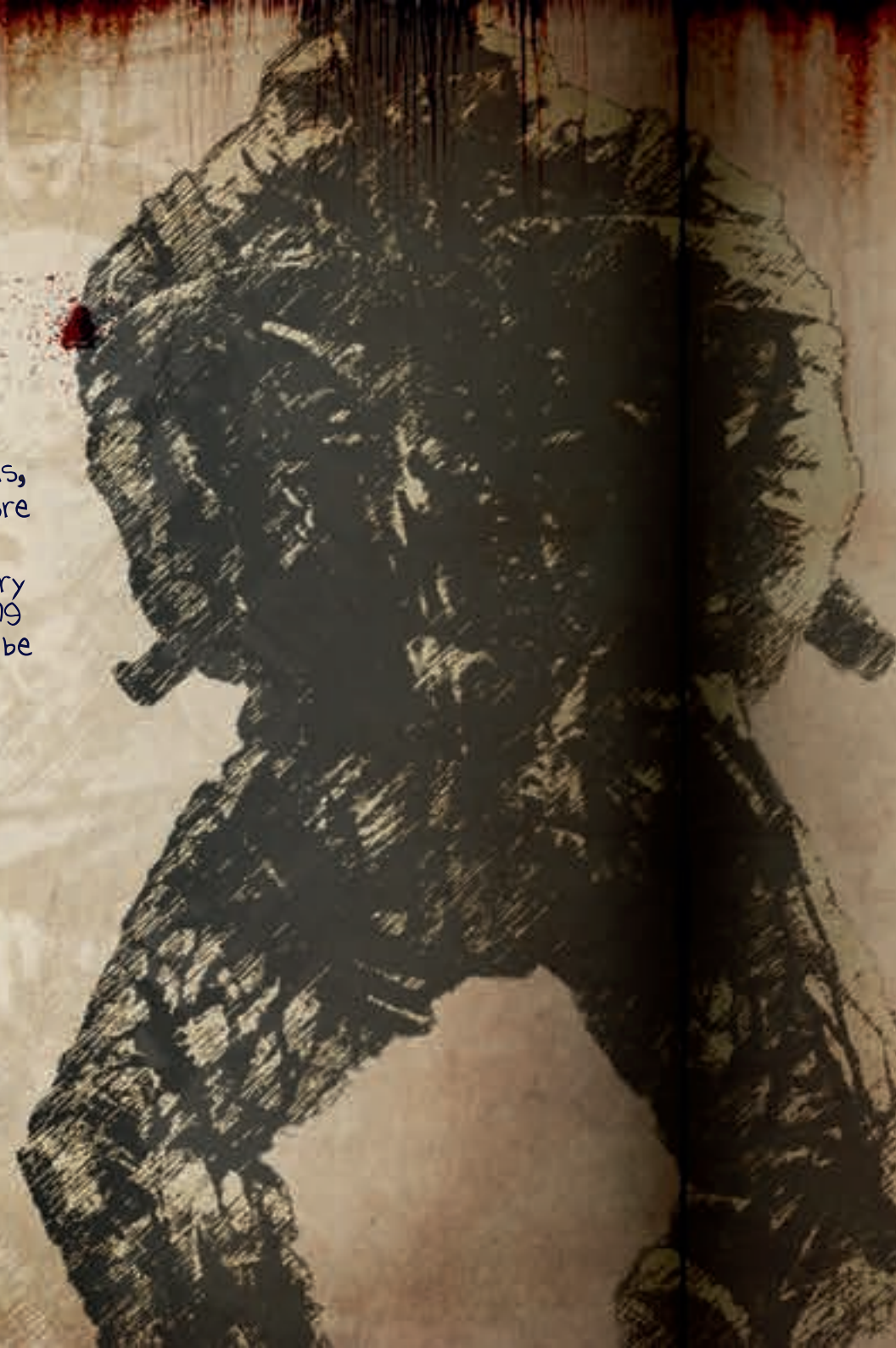






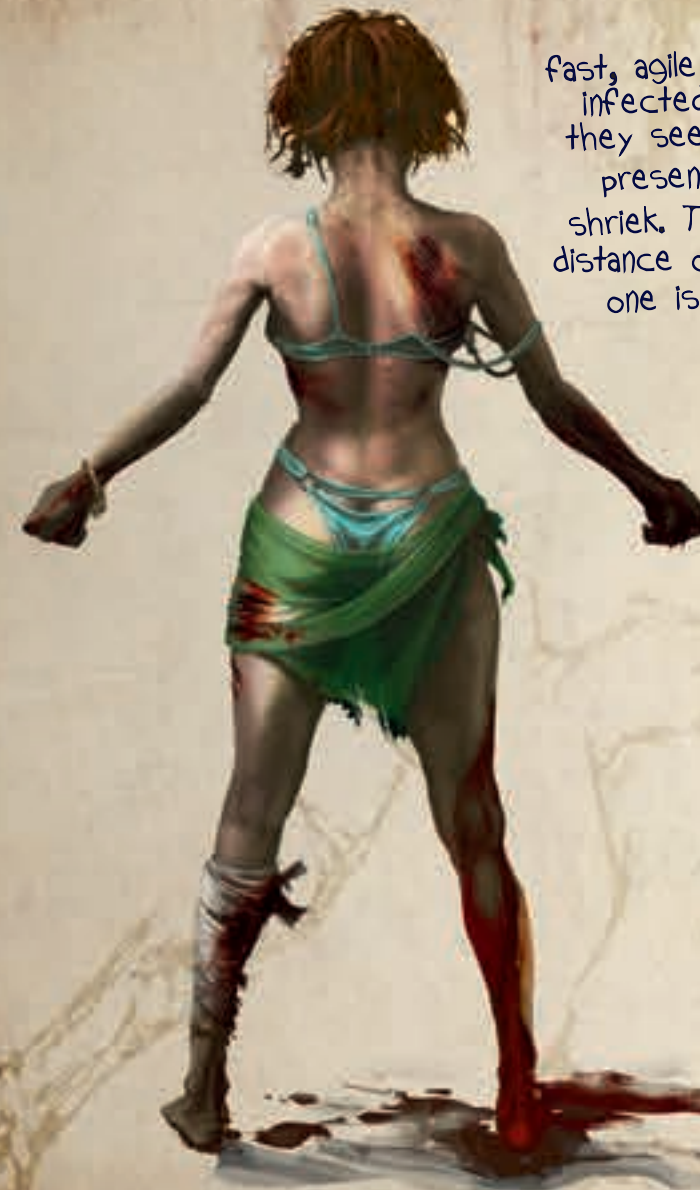

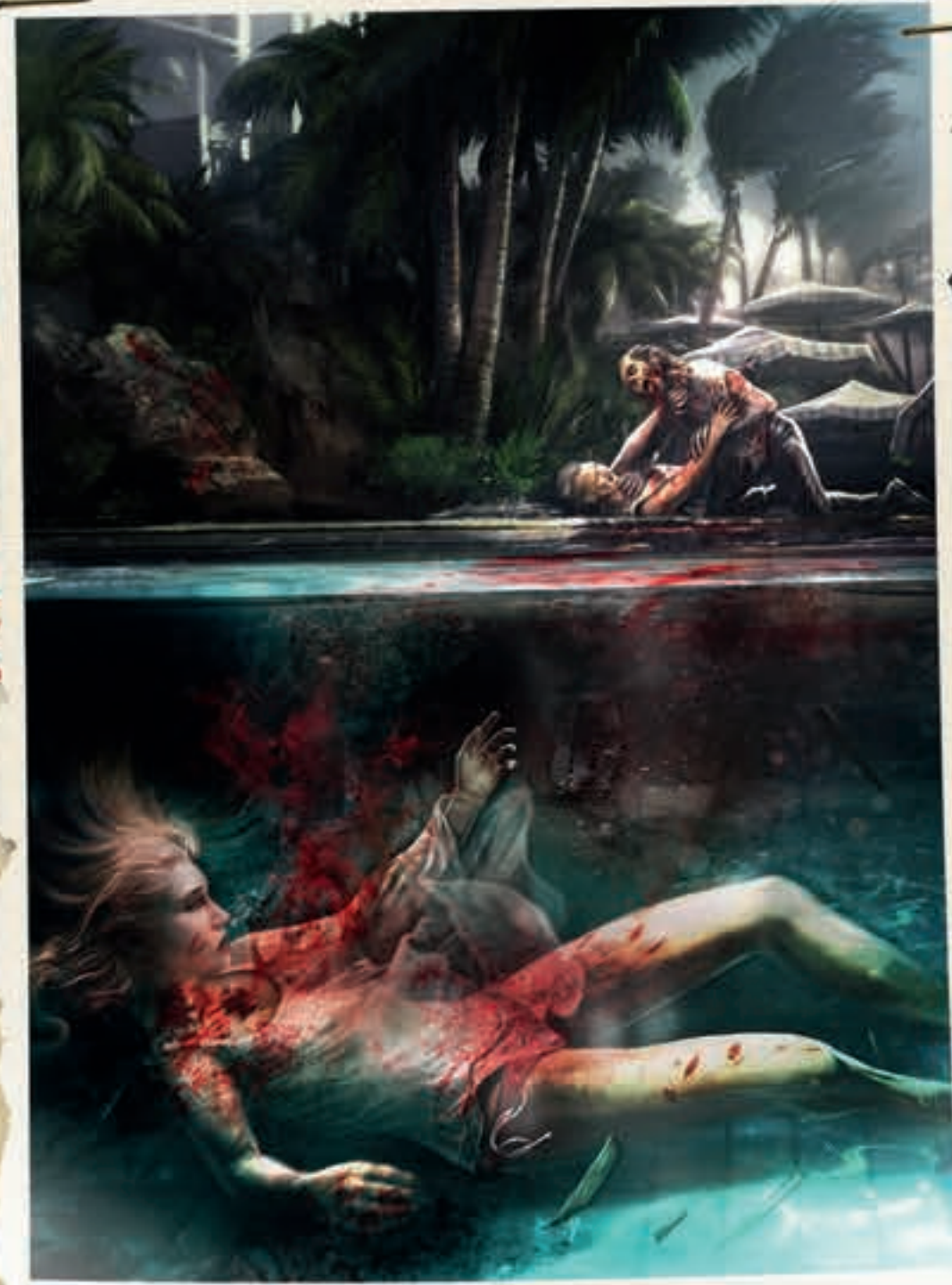
