

## Eligibility

To qualify for these rebates, a seller must sign up for FBA before March 31, 2012, and ship its first units to an Amazon fulfilment centre between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012. The rebates earned will be based only on units received at and/or shipped from a qualified Amazon fulfilment centre between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012.

## Costs and Fees NOT Covered by the Rebate

The rebates earned by the seller will NOT cover any portion of the following costs and fees charged to the seller:

- FBA removal, disposal and return fees for inventory the seller requests Amazon to remove and/or return.
- Fees that are not part of FBA, including:
  - Any sales commission or closing fees charged by Amazon in connection with the sale of any unit.
  - Any subscription fees for any other Amazon programme, including the Pro Merchant service, the Selling on Amazon service and the WebStore by Amazon service.

Amazon EU Sarl ("Amazon") is offering new sellers who register for FBA the opportunity to earn both:

### (a) A Shipping Cost Rebate:

A rebate on the inbound shipping fees incurred by the seller, in relation to non book items up to £ 500 based on the number of inbound units received in Amazon's UK fulfilment centres between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012. Please refer to the rebate schedule on the right for details.

### (b) An FBA Fees Rebate:

A rebate on FBA fees including EFN, storage, labeling and also Multi-Channel fees for off-Amazon.co.uk orders incurred by the seller in relation to non book items up to an amount of £ 1000. The calculation is based on the number of outbound units shipped for the seller through FBA including the European Fulfilment Network (EFN) between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012. Please refer to the rebate schedule on the right for details.

### How it Works

- This offer applies to all non-book shipments received at and/or shipped from a qualified Amazon fulfilment centre between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012 and applies to new sellers who registered for FBA before March 31, 2012.
- Eligible sellers will receive a one-time flat Shipping Cost Rebate as per the above Schedule. For example, if Amazon receives 750 units from the seller between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012, at a shipping cost of £ 350, the seller will receive a Shipping Cost Rebate of £ 300.
- Eligible sellers will also receive a one-time FBA Fees Rebate as per the above schedule. For example, if Amazon ships 750 of the seller's units through FBA to fulfil the seller's Amazon.co.uk and off-Amazon.co.uk orders between January 1, 2012, and March 31, 2012, and the seller incurs £ 850 in FBA fees, the seller will receive an FBA Fees Rebate of £ 700.
- The combined sterling amount of any Shipping Cost Rebate and FBA Fees Rebate earned will be deposited to or used to offset any negative balance in the seller's Amazon Seller Account on or before May 1, 2012. The amount will be titled "Miscellaneous Adjustment."
- The rebate will be the maximum of the figure shown in the table or the actual fees incurred.
- This offer is not "cumulative"; new sellers registering for FBA will only be entitled to one Shipping Cost rebate and one FBA fees rebate only. This applies equally to sellers using the European Fulfilment Network where only the rebate of the home marketplace will apply although the calculation will take into account EFN fees and EFN outbound units shipped.
