

# Disney Cars checklist



Get everyone revved up with a Cars party, complete with super-speedway action and a perfectly decorated pit-stop for refueling.

## Favors

Nothing wins over racing fans like Matchbox cars. Pick up Disney Cars treat bags and fill them with the items below.

- Disney Cars stickers
- Disney Cars treat bags / stationery dept.
- Disney Cards die-cast racers / toy dept.
- Disney Cars stampers / stationery dept.

## Must-have party supplies

- Birthday cake / bakery dept.
- Candles / stationery dept.
- Paper plates and napkins / stationery dept.
- Plastic glasses / stationery dept.
- Garbage bags / cleaning supplies dept.
- Cleaning supplies/ cleaning supplies dept.

## Decorations

Surround the pit crew with Disney Cars memorabilia: Route 66 signs, checkered flags, paper-plate steering wheels and speedometers. Draw a racetrack on a paper tablecloth for Matchbox racing fun during cake time, and give each little driver a plastic trophy cup to drink from.

- Helium tank with balloons / stationery dept.
- Disney Cars plates, cups and napkins / toy dept.
- Paper plates / stationery dept.
- Paint / art supplies dept.
- Tablecloth / stationery dept.
- Paper crepe streamers / stationery dept.

## Activities: the “it” pit stop

Use a large cardboard box to serve as a pit stop. Inside, a large bucket of LEGOs hold all the pieces to build a car. Using a stopwatch, see who can do the quickest pit stop, building a ready-to-race car in the shortest amount of time.

Prep time: 15 min.

Activity time: 30 min.

The supplies you need:

- LEGO sets / toy dept.
- Stopwatch / sports dept.

## More activities

### Ready, set, race

Decorate cardboard boxes to look like cars, making sure they're large enough for kids to step into and carry as auto bodies. Set up a speedway for rookies and racecar fans, using sidewalk chalk outside or masking tape inside, then race for speed, in reverse, and in the silliest ways imaginable.

Prep time: 30 min.

Activity time: 60 min.

The supplies you need:

- Sidewalk chalk / art supplies dept.
- Thick Sharpie marker / home office dept.
- Masking tape / home office dept.
- Paint / art supplies dept.
- Disney Cars coloring book & crayons / electronics dept

### Birthday favorites

How well do all the party guests know the birthday boy or girl? Ask ten easy-to-answer questions, like "What's the birthday boy's favorite color?" or "What's the birthday girl's middle name?" The friend with the most correct answers gets a special prize.

Prep time: 15 min.

Activity time: 15 min.

The supplies you need:

- Notebooks or paper for each guest / home office dept.
- Pens or pencils / home office dept.
- Special prize (can be matched to party theme)

For even more fun, include:

- Board games / toy dept.
- Activity kits (boy, girl, preschool) / toy dept.
