

Spider-Man Party checklist



It's a web-slinging, crime-busting good time when Spidey is on the guest list. So go all-out for your little spider-maniac. Red and black decorations set the mood; and depending on the guests' ages, you can hold a red-carpet screening of the live-action films or the toned-down animated episodes.

Favors

Create action-packed goody bags, filling the Spider-Man treat bags with silly string, small action figures, bouncy balls, plastic spiders, and shoestring licorice for making edible webs.

- Spider-Man treat bags / stationery dept.
- Spider-Man action figures / toy dept.
- Plastic spiders / toy dept.
- Spider-Man bouncy balls / stationery dept.
- Black and red shoestring licorice / grocery dept.

Must-have party supplies

- Birthday cake / bakery dept.
- Candles / stationery dept.
- Paper plates and napkins / stationery dept.
- Plastic glasses / stationery dept.
- Garbage bags / cleaning supplies dept.
- Cleaning supplies/ cleaning supplies dept.

Decorations

Every superhero needs a secret hideaway. Turn your space into a Spider-Den with giant webs made of black crepe paper streamers. Suspend plastic spiders from helium-filled red balloons using curled wrapping ribbon for realistic arachnid motion.

- Helium tank with balloons / cards & party dept.
- Plastic spiders / toy dept.
- Spider-Man plates, cups and napkins / stationery dept.
- Black curling ribbon / stationery dept.
- Black crepe paper streamers / stationery dept.

Activities: Superhero super-bouncing

Bouncy-balls are always a huge hit with kids, but when they're Spider-Man themed, the excitement hits new heights. See if kids can swoosh mini bouncy balls through a basketball hoop, then try to bounce the balls in.

Prep time: 10 min.

Activity time: 60 min.

The supplies you need:

- Spider-Man bouncy balls / stationery dept.
- Basketball hoop / sports dept.

More activities

Comic relief

Time to take a break in the non-stop action? Pass out pages with pre-printed comic-book frames for kids to draw their own Spider-Man adventures. For visual reference, have comic books on hand.

Prep time: 10 min.

Activity time: 45 min.

The supplies you need:

- Drawing paper / art supplies dept.
- Markers / art supplies dept.
- Colored pencils / art supplies dept.
- Stapler / home office dept.

Tangle town

Kids bouncing off the walls? This quick activity is a great fill-in for spare moments between planned events. Have everyone stand in a circle and put their right hands in and grasp a hand, then do the same with left hands. Then, try to untangle the knot—without anyone letting go.

Prep time: None

Activity time: 10 min.

Using your head

Divide party attendees into pairs. One puts on a baseball cap that has a plastic bowl glued to the top. Standing five paces away, their partner tries to throw foam balls into the bowl. See how many each team can land in the bowl, then switch swides.

Prep time: 30 min.

Activity time: 45 min.

The supplies you need:

- Baseball hats / men's clothing dept.
- Plastic bowls / cards & party dept.
- Hot glue gun / Art supplies dept.

For even more fun, include:

- Board games / toy dept.
- Activity kits (boy, girl, preschool) / toy dept.
